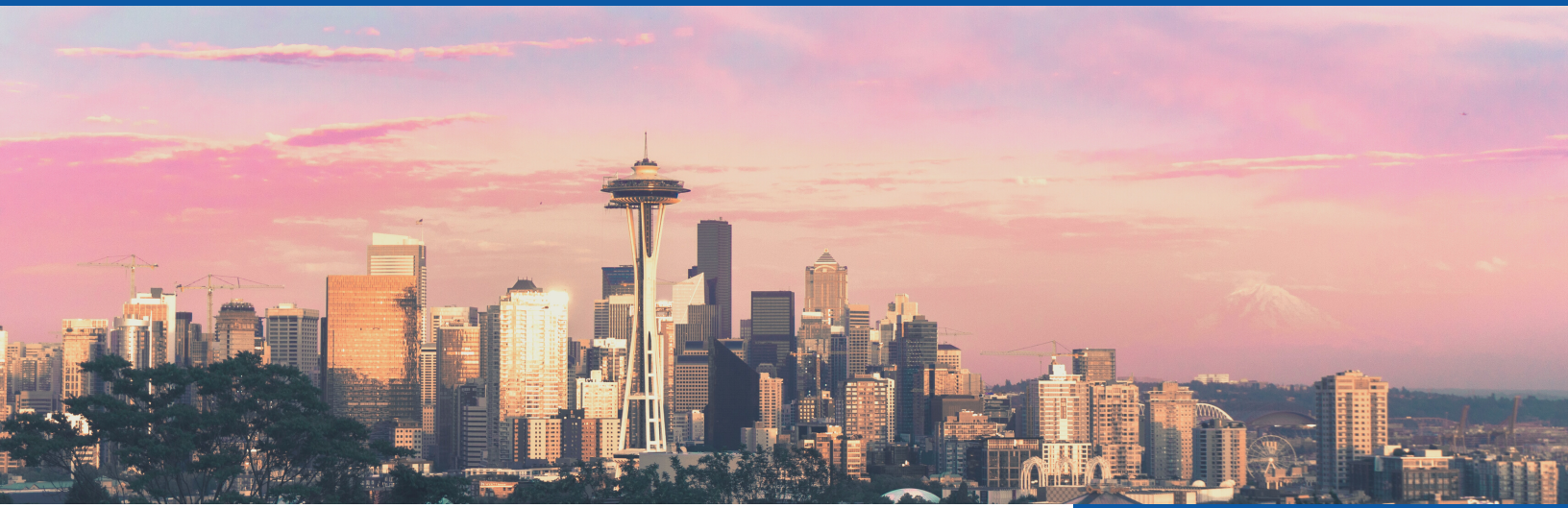

## Pandemic Aid for Washington State Foster Care Alumni is Here

*Are you between the ages of 23 and 26? Did you spend time in foster care after your 15th birthday?*

*If yes, you may be eligible for relief funding to cover expenses related to education, housing, transportation and much more.*

Treehouse is partnering with the Department of Children, Youth, & Families (DCYF) to distribute \$1.65 million in pandemic relief funds to foster care alumni between now and September 30, 2021.

Eligible young adults will receive direct **cash payments of up to \$1,000.**

Funding can be used to help pay for anything related to housing, basic needs, transportation, education, employment and much more.

Applications open up on July 16, 2021 and will close on September 24, 2021.
